Second circular letter of invitation to the 65th session of the SIHDA

1 June 2011

Dear friends of the Société Internationale de l'Histoire des Droits de l'Antiquité,

Time goes by and the 65th session of the SIHDA is approaching! It is thus time to give you some additional information and to remind you of some important upcoming deadlines.

First, I'd like to draw your attention on the registration. As it has been explained before, the registration fee will be of 200 € only for those who register (and pay!) before 30 June 2011. For those paying from 1 July until 15 September, the registration fee will be of 250 €. And for those paying on their arrival in Liège, the fee will be of 300 € (exclusively cash!).

The registrations must be made on our Internet site (www.sihda.org). We kindly ask you to fill in the registration form even if you are not yet in possession of all the information concerning your presence. You will be able to add the missing information later on a second registration form (on the same internet site) allowing you to fill in e.g. the name of your hotel, the title and the summary of your conference... Let me also remind you that it has become urgent to book your hotel room if you haven't done it already!

For those wishing to give a paper at the 65th session, they must send in the title and the summary before 31 July.

I'd like to remind you that French is the official language of the Société Fernand de Visscher. This means that the workshops should be – if possible – chaired in French but that the papers can also be given in German, Italian, English and Spanish. Consequently, the speakers are kindly requested to announce the language of their paper. This information should be inserted when registering on Internet.

The summaries of the papers shall not be longer than 15 lines. If possible, these summaries should be written in French. If this is not possible, summaries in English, German, Italian or Spanish are also welcome.

As usual, the conferences shall not last longer than 20 minutes and it will be asked to the chairwomen and chairmen to enforce the 20 minutes rule without exception.

Certificates of acceptance of your paper can be asked to Julie Debroux (J.Debroux@ulg.ac.be).

Concerning the optional excursion on Saturday 24 September 2011, the organisation has selected 3 options for the participants. These excursions will only take place if at least 25 participants register for it. For evident reasons of bus size, each excursion will be limited to 45 participants.

Option 1: Visit of the Bosteels brewery (where the well known "Kwak" and "Triple Karmeliet" are brewed. The latter is a multiple world champion in its category) and visit of the Grand-Place in Brussels.

Option 2: (Walking) Visit of the historical centre of Liège and visit of the Abbey of Val Dieu (a beautiful and historically important site, where beer and cheese are still produced).

Option 3: Visit of a chocolate-factory ("Charlemagne") and boat-cruise on the Meuse.

The choices of the excursions can be made on the Internet site and will be attributed following the rule "Prior tempore, potior iure...". I remind you that the participation fee for this optional excursion is $50 \in$ (payable together with the registration fee).

A third circular invitation letter will be sent as soon as I have all the titles and the summaries of the papers, hopefully in August. I should then be able to send you the scientific programme of our congress.

I hope that many of you will find their way to Liège. We're looking forward to welcome you!
